The GP PA Preceptorship Scheme is a 2-year, holistic, weekly educational programme. It has been carefully designed and matched with the RCGP curriculum to ensure that it equips PAs with the knowledge, skills, and competencies to compliment on the job experience to help those new to practice integrate to general practice. The programme encases a broad range of topics that focuses on common clinical scenarios, consultation skills and a wider understanding of primary care.

The programme uses a blended learning approach of online and face-to-face with an emphasis on case-based teaching. The programme is underpinned by a commitment to multidisciplinary teaching with a focus on developing a community of practice for Physician Associates within the region.
